All applicants are required to maintain, in addition to any insurance required by law, Comprehensive Liability insurance, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence. The Borough of Branchville must be named as an additional insured on this policy. A certificate of insurance as described must be provided before the facility is used. Failure to enforce the required production of the certificate will not void users' obligation to provide the insurance as aforesaid. In addition, by making this application, the applicant and user agree, that should this application be granted, the applicant and all users will indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the Borough of Branchville against any and all demands, claims, damages, fees, cost and liabilities of any kind (including but not limited to attorneys fees) to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Each User further acknowledges, understands and agrees that:

- 1. The CDC and NJDOH have determined that PANDEMIC ILLNESSES are highly contagious viruses, diseases and medical conditions.
- 2. Exposure to or infection from PANDEMIC ILLNESSES may cause seriouspermanent bodily injury, including respiratory failure, cardiac arrest, and deathin healthy persons of all ages.
- 3. PANDEMIC ILLNESSES may be new. The standards and recommendations on how to prevent and protect against the risk of exposure to infection and the spread of PANDEMIC ILLNESSES may continue to change as more data becomes available.
- 4. PANDEMIC ILLNESSES presently exist and remain prevalent throughoutall areas of the State of New Jersey and continue to infect persons and spread throughout all counties and local communities, including the residents of the Borough.
- 5. PANDEMIC ILLNESSES may have a high probability of spreading to person(s)who are either in direct contact with, or in close proximity to (within about 6 feet or 2 meters) an infected person.
- 6. The CDC and NJDOH believe PANDEMIC ILLNESSES are most likely to spread from person to person by droplets produced into the air when an infected person coughs, sneezes, talks or otherwise moves air out through theirnose and mouth; and from touching/contacting surfaces on which droplets containing the virus exist.
- 7. There may be vaccination(s), immunization(s) available or soon to be available for PANDEMIC ILLNESSES that may or may not prevent Pandemic Illness.
- 8. The CDC and the NJDOH maintain that the best way to prevent and protect against infection and/or spread of PANDEMIC ILLNESSES is to self- quarantine and to avoid contact with other individuals, large gatherings and spending time in public places and buildings.
- 9. The Borough makes its facilities available to persons or organizations that offer to members of the public the option of participating in or attending a variety of indoor and outdoor physical, social, and educational programs and activities, including, without limitation,

competitive and non-competitive sports and sporting events, organized leagues, day camps, games, instructional/training programs, weddings, parades, gatherings, and other events (collectively, "PROGRAMS/USES") which may be helpful for the social, physical, educational and character development and the mental and physical health of the public.

- 10. Attending or participating in any PROGRAM/USE on or at a Borough property or facility poses an inherent risk of infection and a heightened risk of injury from and exposure to PANDEMIC ILLNESSES regardless of the measures taken by the Borough: (i) to avoid close contact with other persons, including infected persons; (ii) to disinfect Borough facilities, equipment and public property; and (iii) to discover, contact trace, and quarantine infected persons and/or personsexhibiting signs and symptoms of infection of PANDEMIC ILLNESSES.
- 11. Attending and/or participating in any PROGRAM/USE at a Borough owned property or facility may also increase the risk of exposure to PANDEMIC ILLNESSES and the further spreading of PANDEMIC ILLNESSES to other family members, PROGRAM/USE PARTICIPANTS, and third persons.

By signing this WAIVER, I/WE do further acknowledge the contagious nature of PANDEMIC ILLNESSES, and that an inherent and heightened risk of danger to infection and exposure to PANDEMIC ILLNESSES exists for all PROGRAM/USE PARTICIPANTS, persons and other participants attending any PROGRAM/USE on or at Borough property or facilities. I/WE acknowledge and agree to voluntarily assume all risks that I/WE, the PROGRAM/USE PARTICIPANT(S), and our other family member(s) may be exposed to or infected by PANDEMIC ILLNESSES by attending or participating in any PROGRAM/USE at a Borough property or facility; and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I/WE understand that the risk ofbecoming exposed to or infected by PANDEMIC ILLNESSES at an event at a Borough property or facility may result from the actions, omissions or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to the Borough officials, officers, employees, and volunteers; and other participants/attendees of the PROGRAM/USE and their families.
